The International Mediterranean Congress of Mathematics Almería 2005 (CIMMA 2005) will be held in **Almería** (south of Spain, 170 km or about 100 miles from Granada) from **June 6 to 10, 2005**. It is part of the cultural program of the XV Mediterranean Games Almería 2005 scheduled for two weeks later. The site of the congress is the modern campus of the University of Almería, located at a beautiful place on the sea shore. Many outstanding mathematicians, mainly from the Mediterranean area, have expressed their interest in participating. The scientific program of the congress will consist of 3 plenary lectures (by F. Catanese, A. Quarteroni, and E. Zelmanov) and 9 thematic sessions, related to lines of research represented in Almería, namely:

1. Algebras and their Representations
2. Geometry and Topology
3. Approximation, Special Functions and Numerical Analysis
4. Functional Analysis and its Applications
5. General Topology and its Applications
6. Probabilistic Spaces, Copulae and T-norms. Applications
7. Random Models and Design of Experiments
8. Financial Mathematics and Mathematical Economics
9. Mathematics Education
