

## COMMUNIQUE OF THE MONITORING GROUP OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ALMERÍA ON COVID-19

## 11.03.2020

Informing the university community of the preventive measures adopted so far by the University of Almería in relation to COVID-19. These measures respond to the indications and recommendations of the health and educational authorities.

- Communication to the affected students of the suspension decreed by the Andalusian Health Service of the external practices that are carried out in public health centers, being affected both degrees, sanitary and non-sanitary.
- 2. Communication to the affected students of the suspension of the teaching activities in which health center workers are involved.
- Individualized communication to ERASMUS students, outgoing and incoming, of the recommendations, indications and instructions of the health and educational authorities of the countries of origin and desitination. UAL students will be facilitated to rejoin our campus.
- 4. Adoption of the necessary measures from the Information and Technology Service to ensure the continuity of work from home in the event of any evantuality. Relating to that, were sent e-mails with technical instructions. Additionally, today a contingency test has been carried out with the STIC staff and it is planned to do that contingency test with the staff of the Economic Management and Human Resources Service on Friday, March 13th.
- 5. Adoption of reinforcement measures in the virtual teaching platform (Blackboard Learn) to ensure the continuity of teaching in the event of any eventuality.
- Reinforcement and adoption of a special working protocol regarding the COVID-19 by the intended cleaning company of the University of Almería. This protocol complies with the indications and recommendations received from the health authorities.
- 7. Postponement suspension of activities and events that, due to their caracteristics, may represent a higher risk according to the instructions of the health authorities. The list of suspended and postponed events, updated in real time, it is published on the web place of the University of Almería enabled to inform about COVID-19.
