1. INTRODUCTION [around 300 words]

The team of Sexology from Unidad de Estudios Sexológicos (UESX) proposes the course "The Science of Sexology". The UESX belongs to the CERNEP Research Center of the University of Almería and is made up of a multidisciplinary team that consists of different Health and Education professionals (Psychology, Education and Medicine), all of them with a long trajectory in Education, Clinic and Research in Sexology.

UESX offers this sexual education course to meet the personal needs of students and to complement their academic training. It is a structured course in basic and empirical concepts of Sexology, framed in positive Sexology, in order to optimize the personal and professional growth of the participants.

Currently most people have not received quality sex education, which leads to living with feelings of guilt, shame and / or fear. This course arises from the need to break with the current vision of sexuality (a preventive, reductionist and pathologizing vision) and promote a holistic and hedonistic vision of it.

This course offers a comprehensive sexuality education in order to live a more positive sexuality. In this training, the students will know different sexological concepts and will develop a positive attitude towards sexuality, this will allow to enhance and develop their skills, abilities and values (assertive communication, self-esteem, respect, empathy, among others) in order to improve their quality of life. Thanks to this training, people will be able to make decisions freely, maturely and safely.

The main objective of this course is to offer basic sexological knowledge and promote positive sexuality, through comprehensive sexual education, to develop the personal and professional growth of students in the field of Sexology.






2. OBJECTIVES

4. METHODOLOGY [200-250 words]

UESX works from a positive, holistic and hedonistic approach to sexuality; understanding diversity and sexual democracy in relationships as a value that enriches our sexuality.

All sessions will be based on these three principles, where the participants through experiential dynamics will be able to acquire the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary to achieve personal and professional growth of optimal sexuality.

The course has a theoretical-practical nature in order to acquire knowledge in a dynamic way to enrich the teaching-learning process. It is divided into four modules, which will be taught by the multidisciplinary team of the UESX (Health and Education Professionals), all of them specialized in the field of Sexology. The course is offered in Spanish and English.

The methodology used in this course is dynamic and participatory. It is about that those involved participate actively since they are the main element in this process. The participants' prior knowledge, age and needs will be taken into account. Therefore, one can speak of an open and flexible methodology. The contents are achieved through experiential dynamics in order to promote meaningful, functional and transferable learning.

5. PROFESSIONAL VISITS AND COMPLEMENTARY ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

In the last module there will be a guided visit to the Sexological Studies Unit (UESX) and a dynamic and interactive activity will be developed with the participants.

6. ASSESSMENT

Elements to be evaluated:

- 3. Final test. At the end of each module, 45 minutes will be reserved to carry out the activity decided by the expert, to evaluate the knowledge acquired (debates, group work, personal reflection, among others)
