How Learner Skills Impact Studying with a Smartphone and Achievement: Implications for Studying Languages

Description

In this talk, Dr. Hartley will describe the benefits and challenges the smartphone presents for student learning. In particular, he will present data that demonstrates how the self-regulation skills of the learner impact their use of the smartphone while studying. He will also share his work that addresses the challenges with a brief intervention designed to reduce smartphone distractions and improve student learning. He will conclude with a discussion of how these results impact language learning.

Biography

Dr. Hartley teaches courses in instructional design, online learning, and multimedia development at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, US. His research publications have been cited over 4000 times and address important questions about the impact of technology and self-regulated learning skills on student achievement.
